Financial Management Services (FMS) Transition

- Recap from the First Stakeholder Meeting
 - OLTL currently contracts with one Vendor Fiscal/Employer Agent (F/EA)
 for CHC, OBRA, and Act 150 for Financial Management Services (FMS).
 - CHC Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Waiver Changes
 - FMS will transition from an OLTL-contracted FMS vendor to an administrative function of the CHC-MCOs.
 - CHC-MCOs will manage the selection and oversight of the FMS vendor(s) for CHC Participants who have selected the Participant-directed model of services.



Financial Management Services (FMS) Transition

- Strategy for Fee-For-Service Home and Community-Based Services
 Programs
 - FMS for the OBRA and Act 150 programs will be separate from CHC
 FMS operations moving forward.
 - Based on additional feedback received from internal and external stakeholders, OLTL is proceeding with separate procurement activities for a single vendor to complete FMS tasks for OBRA and Act 150.
 - This approach will be part of a joint procurement with the Office of Developmental Programs.
