Dear colleague,

Over the past year, overdose incidents and overdose-related deaths have risen at historic rates across the United States and in many communities across Pennsylvania. As public health leaders managing hospitals within the Commonwealth, your organization plays a vital role in providing emergency care, referrals to treatment, and other supports that provide a lifeline for individuals struggling with substance use disorder (SUD).

Access to intranasal naloxone, or Narcan®, is a critical part of these efforts. Recently, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania launched a new Statewide Naloxone Allocation Portal, creating a new opportunity for organizations serving Pennsylvanians at greatest risk of overdose to request Narcan® kits to support their lifesaving work. If your organization is interested in receiving a supply of Narcan® to support hospital- and/or community-based naloxone distribution efforts, please submit a request through PCCD's <u>Statewide Naloxone</u> <u>Allocation Request Portal</u> as soon as you can. We would welcome the opportunity to work with you to determine your needs and provide a supply for distribution heading into the fall.
