FMS Transition



FMS Transition

- The CHC FMS Transition was extended to a new Go-Live date of July 1, 2022.
 - Tempus and CHC MCOs priority is getting paperwork back from common law employers (participants) and their DCWs.
 - 80% Common Law Employers and 80% of DCW had returned information (packets)
- In-person meetings in June offered assistance to over 2900 members.
- Participants can contact their Service Coordinator for assistance in setting up and being trained on their EVV responsibilities.
- Participants or their DCWs can contact the MCO if they cannot touch base with their SC specifically



FMS Transition

- The most recent FMS Transition Stakeholder Meeting took place on June 17th.
 - The next scheduled Stakeholder Meeting will occur on July 1st.
- Tempus and the CHC-Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) are focused on improving communication, specifically call-center operations. Tempus in in process of onboarding more staff to take calls timely.
 - Callers should use Tempus' call back feature by placing calls early in the morning to assure a call will be returned same day.



CHC 2022 Agreement



CHC 2022 Agreement

- Added a requirement that the CHC-MCOs pay for Personal Assistance Services at no less than the FFS level.
- Addition of value-based purchasing requirements. Requires for 2022 that 15% of the medical portion of the capitation be expended through VBP and 7.5% of LTSS payments.
- Addition of language related to the transition of oversight of financial management services in the Participant-Directed model of care from the Department to the CHC-MCOs.
- Addition of a Nursing Facility Quality Incentive Program providing incentive payments tied to the following quality metrics



CHC 2022 Agreement

- Added a CHC-MCO Pay for Performance program for the following measures:
 - Comprehensive Assessments (CAU)
 - Care Plans (CPU)
 - Reassessments and Care Planning after Inpatient Discharge (RAC)
 - Sharing Care Plans with PCP (SCP)
 - CAPHS Health Plan Survey- Overall Satisfaction with Health Plan (Aligned/Medicaid only population)
 - CAPHS Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Survey-Person Centered Service Plan (PCSP) included all things important to you
 - Nursing Home Transition

Philadelphia NF Closure

- Philadelphia Nursing Facility announced to the Department of Health it intent to close and provided 120 days notice.
 - The projected date of closure is October 28, 2022.
- OLTL, CHC MCOs and Philadelphia City officials have engaged in ongoing discussions to discuss the closure and the transition plans for the nursing facility residents.
 - MCO's are performing outreach to individuals
- Individual enrollment status:
 - 98% Medicaid
 - 38% Keystone/AHC
 - 37% UPMC
 - 23% PHW
 - 2% Medicare



Philadelphia NF Closure

- CHC Agreement Requirements
 - CHC Agreement Section V: Program Requirements BB Provider Network
 - CHC Agreement Exhibit V: CHC-MCO REQUIREMENTS FOR PROVIDER TERMINATIONS
 - A. Notification to Department
 - 90 days prior to date provider will no longer participate.
 - CHC MCOs submit provider termination work plan within 10 days to Department – weekly status updates
 - Identify participants impacted
 - Outreach plan
 - B. Notification to Participants
 - Participants notified 45 days prior to the effective date of the termination
